

Toll Golf Division Supports Our Troops in "Patriot Golf Day"

September 2009 - Six Country Clubs within Toll Brothers Golf Division, proudly participated in *Patriot Golf Day* over Labor Day weekend, September 4th - 6th. *Patriot Golf Day*, founded by Major Dan Rooney in 2007, is a PGA sponsored national program that has raised over 3 million dollars and has presented more than 550 educational scholarships to the *Folds of Honor Foundation* since its inception. The *Folds of Honor Foundation* is a nonprofit organization that provides postsecondary educational scholarships for the children and spouses of military men and women disabled or killed while serving our great nation.

Over Labor Day weekend, the participating Toll Brothers' Country Clubs (Belmont, Brier Creek, Dominion Valley, Frenchman's Reserve, Hampton Hall, Jupiter and Regency at Dominion Valley) asked golfers to add an extra dollar to their greens fees to help fund the *Folds of Honor Foundation*.

In an effort to generate as much money as possible for this very worthy cause, each Club sponsored special games and contests over the three days for all Members to participate, in which portions of the proceeds were added to donation. As an additional note, Dominion Valley's Food & Beverage operation donated \$1 for every lunch and dinner entrée ordered. Out of all of the Clubs, Jupiter Country Club contributed the most amount of money with a total of \$2,487.

At the end of the weekend, Toll Brothers' Country Clubs were proud to announce that a combined total of \$8,378 went directly to the *Folds of Honor Foundation*. Many thanks and heart felt gratitude go to each Club team for hosting a truly remarkable event for such a noble cause.
